

# **CSE 8997: Teaching Assistantship**

Georgia Institute of Technology

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## **Course Description**

Supervised teaching experience for graduate students. Students assist in the instruction of undergraduate or graduate courses under the supervision of a faculty member, gaining experience in pedagogy, grading, and course administration.

## **Course Objectives / Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Effectively communicate technical concepts to students.
- Assist in the preparation and delivery of course materials.
- Provide constructive feedback through grading and office hours.
- Develop skills in time management and instructional design.

## **Required Course Materials**

None. Materials related to the assigned course will be provided by the supervising instructor.

## **Grading Policy**

- Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grading.
- Evaluation is based on the quality of teaching assistance, reliability, and professionalism as assessed by the supervising faculty member.

## **Attendance Policy**

Students are expected to fulfill all assigned teaching duties, including attending lectures, holding office hours, and attending grading sessions as scheduled. Absences should be communicated to the supervising instructor in advance.

## **Additional Criteria for Successful Completion**

Students must satisfactorily complete all assigned teaching duties for the duration of the semester as determined by the supervising faculty member.
